This will give you the opportunity to apply your existing payment towards a future trip within the next 24 months. Although our suppliers did not have to provide these future travel credits, they have all done the right thing. We are also most pleased of their extraordinary efforts in repatriation flights in getting Canadians home. Sunwing alone provided Canadians with 3,000 free return flights. It's in these moments, and in seeing the dedication of my team and all all professional travel agents around the world who worked effortlessly in serving travel clients, I am most proud to be in the industry that I love and cherish so much.

So if your trip has been affected by these cancellations, we are working now at issuing these future travel credits. Your existing invoice will revert to a Future Travel Credit for which you can re-book at any time you feel comfortable. We had MANY weddings also affected and many are rebooking for the fall or for 2021. Nobody wants to cancel their wedding but postponements we can all live with. We remain dedicated in finding the next best date.

We thank you again for the continued support and understanding that you have shown. We are together in this mission to combat the spread of this virus. The world is TRULY a most beautiful place and so are our people. We look forward to the continuation of serving your travel needs in the future, when we all come out of isolation and ready to get back out there.
