NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST REQUIREMENT

As of January 7, 2021, all air passengers five years of age or older will be required to test negative for COVID-19 before traveling from another country to Canada. This includes visitors and returning Canadian citizens. Documentation of a negative laboratory test result must be presented to the airline prior to boarding a flight to Canada.

The test must be performed using a COVID-19 molecular polymerase chain reaction (or PCR) test and must be taken within 72 hours prior to the traveller's scheduled departure to Canada. Travellers to Canada must use the ArriveCAN App or website and provide accurate contact information and their quarantine plan on or before entry.

Canadians who are currently travelling and returning to Canada soon should start immediately arranging for a COVID-19 test, to avoid a delay to their return to Canada and those who are planning a future trip outside of Canada, should make their plans for this test prior to their return.

FLIGHT SUSPENSIONS

Starting January 31st, 2021, Air Canada, Westjet, Sunwing and Transat will be suspending operations to the Caribbean and Mexico destinations until April 30th, 2021. Our team is working hard at rebooking and bringing home those affected clients in destination as our top priority. For those other affected clients, a refund will automatically be paid back to the original form of payment. If you had paid by Future Travel Credit, it will go back to your Future Travel Credit account. Please allow us, and the airlines/tour operators, time in processing all refunds and updated invoices.

MANDATORY PCR TEST UPON ARRIVAL

Starting shortly, all international flights can only land in Toronto, Montreal, Calgary and Vancouver and all incoming passengers will be required to take a mandatory PCR test upon arrival.

QUARANTINE HOTELS

All travellers will have to wait up to three days at an approved hotel for the test results at their own expense, which will cost upwards of \$2,000 as advised by Prime Minister, Trudeau.

TEST RESULTS

Those with a negative test result, must finished the remainder of their 14-day isolation as mandated by the Quarantine Act, with increased surveillance. Those with a positive test result, will be transferred to a government facility to quarantine and undergo further testing to ensure there are no variants of Covid-19.

According to the latest data, only 1.8% of all COVID-19 cases in Canada are connected to international travel, but it's important that we all continue to do our part in stopping the spread of this infectious virus.

If your trip with a Canadian tour operator was cancelled in 2020 due to COVID-19, your invoice has been converted to a Future Travel Voucher and all previous payments made, will be your credit. This credit will allow you to re-book any future travel. If booked with a USA supplier, you would have received a refund by them. If not, please contact us.
